Troy Schumacher's ensemble enters its sixth season with a program of new works. Schumacher, who is also a dancer with New York City Ballet, has developed a unique approach. Each project is a three-way collaboration between an artist or writer, a composer, and Schumacher himself. This time around, his collaborators are two architects, Carlos Arnaiz and James Ramsey, and two young composers, Judd Greenstein and Ellis Ludwig-Leone. (The music will be played by Hotel Elefant; all the dancers are from N.Y.C.B.) One of the ballets is inspired by Ramsey's designs for the Lowline, an underground park planned for the Lower East Side.
